PART RELINQUISHMENT REPORT

INTRODUCTION The Murray River Act came into effect in November 2003. As a result of this, PIRSA requested Meningie Gypsum to relinquish some ground in the western part of EL 2877. About 10 km², west of 139017'E has been relinquished. The location is given in **Figure 1**.

EXPLORATION Air photo interpretation and follow up ground reconnaissance have failed to reveal any salt lakes within this area likely to contain gypsum.

EXPENDITURE The estimated expenditure on the relinquished section of Exploration Licence 2877 is \$200.

CONCLUSION No significant carbonates or other industrial minerals were discovered within EL2877 west of 139⁰17'E. This ground, of approximate area 10km², is hereby relinquished.
