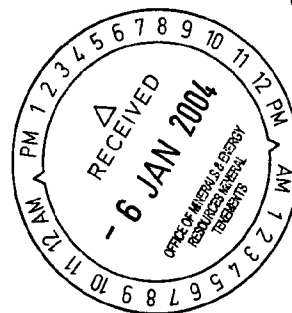

PART RELINQUISHMENT REPORT

INTRODUCTION The Murray River Act came into effect in November 2003. As a result of this, PIRSA requested Agricola Mining to relinquish some ground in the northern part of EL 2782, adjacent to the Coorong National Park. About 3.5km², north of 36°33'S has been relinquished.


EXPLORATION Air photo interpretation revealed the presence of a salt lake extending south into EL 2782 from the adjacent Coorong National Park. This was tested by two push tube holes, put down in 1994 (under an earlier tenement, EL1891, held by S & CR Kennedy), and 2001. Lithologs are given below and locations are shown in **Figure 1**.

No analysis was carried out on these samples.

EXPENDITURE The estimated expenditure on the relinquished section of Exploration Licence 2782 is \$500.

CONCLUSION No significant carbonates or other industrial minerals were discovered within EL2782 north of 36°33'S. This ground, of approximate area 3.5km², is hereby relinquished.
